## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in Department of Military Affairs,
- further providing for advisory councils for veterans' homes.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 704(a), (b), (d) and (f) of Title 51 of
- 7 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the
- 8 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 704. Advisory councils for veterans' homes.
- 10 (a) Establishment of advisory council. -- There is hereby
- 11 established an advisory council for each veterans' home operated
- 12 by the Commonwealth to provide stakeholders with a means to
- 13 <u>advise the Adjutant General on the resident care, management,</u>
- 14 operations and compliance of facilities and services in
- 15 veterans' homes to ensure high-quality health care and well-
- 16 <u>being for residents of veterans' homes</u>. Each advisory council
- 17 shall consist of 15 members and the Adjutant General or the

3	(1) [Twelve] <u>Thirteen</u> of the members shall be appointed	<
4	by the Governor from a list of nominations submitted to the	
5	Adjutant General +by the Pennsylvania War Veterans' Council.]	<
6	in accordance with the following: THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:	<
7	(1) THIRTEEN OF THE MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE	
8	GOVERNOR FROM A LIST OF NOMINATIONS SUBMITTED TO THE ADJUTANT	-
9	GENERAL BY THE PENNSYLVANIA WAR VETERANS' COUNCIL IN	
10	ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING:	
11	(i) Ten of the members shall be from a list of	<
12	nominations submitted by veterans from the local	
13	community of the veterans' home. APPOINTEES UNDER THIS	<
14	SUBPARAGRAPH MUST BE VETERANS.	
15	(ii) Three of the members shall be from a list of	
16	nominations submitted by the current residents of the	
17	veterans' home and shall include a family member of a	
18	current or former resident of the veterans' home.	
19	(2) The Adjutant General shall ensure that each nominee	
20	for appointment on each advisory council under paragraph (1)	
21	is a member of the local community of the veterans' home.	
22	(3) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the	
23	President pro tempore of the Senate shall each appoint one	
24	member from their respective bodies to serve on each council.	
25	[The remaining member on the advisory council shall be	
26	selected by the residents of the veterans' homes.]	
27	(4) The department shall designate a subject matter	
28	expert to attend each advisory council's meeting to provide	
29	input on the resident care, management, operations and	
30	compliance of facilities and services in each veterans' home.	

- 1 (b) Term of office and officers.--
- 2 (1) Each member of the councils appointed from the
- 3 General Assembly shall serve for the duration of that General
- 4 Assembly. [The eight] Except as provided under paragraph (2),
- 5 <u>the thirteen</u> members appointed by the Governor shall serve a
- 6 term of three [years, provided that the initial eight members
- 7 selected by the Governor shall serve as follows: three
- 8 members for one year, three members for two years and two
- 9 members for three years as designated by the Governor.]
- 10 years.
- 11 (2) The initial thirteen members selected by the
- 12 <u>Governor on or after the effective date of this paragraph</u>
- shall serve as follows: four members for one year, four
- 14 <u>members for two years and five members for three years as</u>
- designated by the Governor.
- 16 <u>(3)</u> Each council shall organize as soon as possible and
- 17 shall annually elect a president, vice president and
- secretary from the voting members.

- 20 (d) Quorum and time of meetings.--[Six] <u>Eight</u> members of a
- 21 council shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting
- 22 the business of the council. Each advisory council shall meet at
- 23 least quarterly and at other times at the call of the president.
- 24 Each advisory council shall conduct meetings in accordance with
- 25 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating to open meetings).
- 26 \* \* \*
- 27 (f) Power and duty of advisory councils. -- Each veterans'
- 28 home advisory council shall advise the Adjutant General as to
- 29 the resident care, management, operation and the [adequacy]
- 30 compliance of facilities and services at their respective homes.

- 1 (g) Annual reports. -- Each advisory council shall submit an
- 2 <u>annual report to the department that identifies the work of the</u>
- 3 advisory council, includes an overall assessment of the resident
- 4 care, management, operations and compliance of facilities and
- 5 <u>services in each veterans' home and provides recommendations.</u>
- 6 The department shall submit a consolidated report on the annual
- 7 reports submitted by each advisory council under this subsection
- 8 to the Adjutant General and the chair and minority chair of the
- 9 <u>Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the</u>
- 10 Senate and the chair and minority chair of the Veterans Affairs
- 11 and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the House of
- 12 Representatives no later than January 30, 2024, and each year
- 13 thereafter.
- 14 Section 2. The amendment or addition of 51 Pa.C.S. § 704(a)
- 15 (1) and (2) and (b) (1) and (2) shall apply upon the expiration
- 16 of a member's term on the advisory council appointed by the
- 17 Governor before the effective date of this section.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
