AN ACT

- 1 Designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 403 over the
- Two Lick Creek, Borough of Clymer, Indiana County as the
- 3 Sergeant James Robert Pantall Memorial Bridge.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Sergeant James Robert Pantall Memorial Bridge.
- 7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Sergeant James Robert Pantall grew up in the Borough
- of Clymer, where he attended Penns Manor High School.
- 11 (2) Sergeant Pantall served his country honorably in
- 12 Vietnam as a member of the 329th Transportation Company, 5th
- 13 Transportation Command.
- 14 (3) On November 3, 1970, Sergeant Pantall was a
- 15 passenger on Landing Craft Utility #63 that capsized five
- nautical miles south of the port at Tan My, Vietnam. His
- 17 remains were not recovered.
- 18 (b) Designation. -- The bridge located on State Route 403 in
- 19 the Borough of Clymer, Indiana County over the Two Lick Creek is

- 1 hereby designated the Sergeant James Robert Pantall Memorial
- 2 Bridge.
- 3 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 4 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 5 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 6 Section 2. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
