A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of May 12 through 18, 2019, as "Women's
2 Lung Health Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Every eight minutes, one woman in the United States
4 loses her battle with lung cancer; and

5 WHEREAS, Lung cancer is the number one cancer killer of women
6 and men in the nation; and

7 WHEREAS, Advocacy and increased awareness will result in
8 screening and early detection for people with lung cancer that
9 will ultimately save lives; and

10 WHEREAS, Public support for research funding will result in
11 better treatment and early detection methods that will
12 ultimately save lives; and

13 WHEREAS, LUNG FORCE is a national initiative led by the
14 American Lung Association that unites women and their loved ones
15 across the country to stand together for lung health and against
16 lung cancer; therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of May 12

1 through 18, 2019, as "Women's Lung Health Week" in Pennsylvania;
2 and be it further

3 RESOLVED, That the Senate encourage all residents of this
4 Commonwealth to learn more about lung cancer, risk factors and
5 screening options.
