A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and legacy of the late Reverend Billy Graham.
- WHEREAS, William Franklin Graham, Jr., passed away in his
- 3 North Carolina home on February 21, 2018, at 99 years of age;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham was widely regarded as "America's
- 6 Pastor" due to his innumerable contributions to American life
- 7 and culture; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham specifically had an instrumental
- 9 influence on American morality during a crucial time in our
- 10 country's history when, to many, morals seemed less than
- 11 absolute; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham completed more than half a century
- 13 of ministry where he preached to more people in live audiences
- 14 than anyone else in history; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham was among the first in the
- 16 evangelical community to capitalize on the booming technological
- 17 advances of the time, utilizing television, radio and the press

- 1 to spread his message of hope to millions of people across the
- 2 globe; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham's sermons were translated into 48
- 4 languages to be shared with nearly 215 million people in 185
- 5 countries since he began his ministry in October 1947; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham provided personal guidance and
- 7 religious counsel to nearly all of our nation's presidents in
- 8 the last century, as well as to many other political and
- 9 influential leaders; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham guided our nation through many
- 11 critical moments in history, including reading from Scripture at
- 12 the funeral services for President Richard Nixon, leading a
- 13 prayer service for the victims of 9/11 at the National Cathedral
- 14 and traveling to New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina to offer
- 15 prayer and support for those affected by the disaster; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham adamantly opposed segregation and as
- 17 such is lauded for breaking with tradition by refusing to preach
- 18 to racially segregated crowds, proclaiming that Christianity is
- 19 not for one race, gender or ethnicity, but for all; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham's upstanding morals and strict
- 21 ethical standards allowed him to oversee a ministry nearly
- 22 untouched by infidelity, financial fraud or other scandals; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham appeared on Gallup's annual list of
- 24 most admired men and women 61 times since 1955; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham received the Presidential Medal of
- 26 Freedom from President Ronald Reagan in 1983 for his
- 27 inspirational leadership in spreading the Gospel to every corner
- 28 of the globe; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Reverend Graham authored more than 30 books, hosted
- 30 his own radio program (Hour of Decision) and various television

- 1 shows, published Decision magazine and founded the Billy Graham
- 2 Evangelistic Association, an organization dedicated to
- 3 evangelistic ministry, as well as equipping others to spread the
- 4 Word of God; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 recognize the profound impact that Reverend Billy Graham has had
- 7 not only on American values and culture but also on individual
- 8 lives around the world through his ministry and his foundation;
- 9 and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 honor the significant accomplishments and preserve the lasting
- 12 legacy of an extraordinary leader; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 extend its deepest condolences to the family members surviving
- 15 Reverend Graham, including his 5 children, 19 grandchildren and
- 16 numerous great-grandchildren, many of whom are also involved in
- 17 ministry; and be it further
