A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of September 2024 as "National Recovery Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, According to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health
- 4 Services Administration (SAMHSA), 29 million Americans have a
- 5 substance use disorder and 21 million of these Americans are in
- 6 recovery; and
- 7 WHEREAS, According to the PA Open Data website, 299,000
- 8 Pennsylvanians are estimated to have an opioid use disorder; and
- 9 WHEREAS, While drug overdose rates in this Commonwealth have
- 10 recently declined, an estimated 4,717 Pennsylvanians died from
- 11 drug overdoses in 2023 according to the PA Open Data website;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, Many Pennsylvanians are close to someone, whether
- 14 its their parents, children, siblings, neighbors, colleagues or
- 15 friends, working to overcome substance use and mental health
- 16 disorders; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Struggling individuals need support and resources

- 1 during their recovery process; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The recovery process can be difficult and having the
- 3 necessary financial resources, support from family and friends
- 4 and a healthy environment is critical to success; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Recognizing this month, recommits our support to the
- 6 prevention, treatment and recovery of individuals with substance
- 7 use and mental health disorders; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Since 1989, "National Recovery Month" has been a
- 9 national observance held every September; and
- 10 WHEREAS, This observance promotes and supports new evidence-
- 11 based treatment and recovery practices, supports the recovery
- 12 community and recognizes the dedication of service providers and
- 13 communities who make recovery in all its forms possible; and
- 14 WHEREAS, All residents of this Commonwealth are invited to
- 15 participate in this observance by coming together and
- 16 celebrating individuals in recovery and offering support to
- 17 those still living with substance use and mental health
- 18 disorders; therefore be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of September
- 20 2024 as "National Recovery Month" in Pennsylvania.
