A RESOLUTION

1 Designating May 1, 2018, as "Silver Star Families of America  
2 Day" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has always proudly  
4 honored the sacrifices of the men and women in the United States  
5 Armed Forces; and

6 WHEREAS, The Silver Star Families of America was formed to  
7 ensure that we remember the blood sacrifices of our wounded  
8 servicepersons by designing and manufacturing a silver star  
9 banner and flag; and

10 WHEREAS, The members of the Silver Star Families of America  
11 have worked tirelessly to provide the wounded armed forces  
12 members of this Commonwealth and our country with silver star  
13 banners, flags and care packages; and

14 WHEREAS, The Silver Star Families of America's mission is to  
15 ensure that seeing a silver star banner displayed in a window or  
16 a star flag flying causes people to remember those who have

1 sacrificed for their state and country; and

2 WHEREAS, It is the wish of the people of Pennsylvania that  
3 the sacrifices of so many servicepersons never be forgotten;  
4 therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate May 1, 2018, as "Silver  
6 Star Families of America Day" in Pennsylvania to honor its  
7 commitment to our wounded armed forces members.
