A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2020 as "Septic Smart Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Proper septic system use and routine care are vital
- 4 to protecting public health, preserving our highly valued
- 5 groundwater, lakes, streams and waterways and avoiding costly
- 6 repairs that can result from neglect; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Maintenance of on-lot septic systems is vital to the
- 8 health and well-being of the 26% of the households in this
- 9 Commonwealth who rely on a septic system; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania residents and our environment benefit
- 11 from properly designed, installed, operated and maintained
- 12 septic systems; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Failure of consumers to understand how septic
- 14 systems operate and how to ensure their continued utility can
- 15 mean tremendous costs to the property owner and reduced ability
- 16 for the property to be sold; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Wastewater professionals across Pennsylvania use

- 1 their expertise in the design, installation, maintenance and
- 2 regulation of septic systems; and
- 3 WHEREAS, These professionals, including members of the
- 4 Pennsylvania Septage Management Association, have worked to
- 5 educate consumers about the importance of maintaining septic
- 6 systems and the perils of not doing so; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The United States Environmental Protection Agency's
- 8 SepticSmart program used by Pennsylvania health officials also
- 9 educates homeowners about the need for proper septic system use
- 10 and routine maintenance; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Recognizing limited public wastewater treatment
- 12 resources, on-lot septic systems provide an important
- 13 environmentally friendly function in preventing effluent from
- 14 human waste from entering Pennsylvania's streams and rivers; and
- 15 WHEREAS, It is paramount that we continue working to protect
- 16 and safeguard Pennsylvania's water resources for future
- 17 generations; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of September
- 19 2020 as "Smart Septic Month" in Pennsylvania.
