## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of November 13 through 19, 2024, as "Transgender Awareness Week" and November 20, 2024, as 1

- "Transgender Day of Remembrance" in Pennsylvania. 3
- 4 WHEREAS, "Transgender Awareness Week" is a time for
- transgender people and their allies to take action and bring 5
- 6 attention to the community by educating the public and advancing
- advocacy around the issues of prejudice, discrimination and 7
- 8 violence that affect the transgender community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Individuals and organizations around the country
- 10 annually participate in "Transgender Awareness Week" to help
- 11 raise the visibility of transgender and gender-expansive people
- 12 and hold space to lift up transgender people's sharing of their
- 13 own stories, joys and experiences; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The day following "Transgender Awareness Week" is
- November 20 and this day, known as "Transgender Day of 15
- 16 Remembrance," began in 1999 by transgender advocate Gwendolyn
- Ann Smith as a vigil to honor the memory of Rita Hester, a 34-17
- year-old Black transgender woman who was the victim of an 18

- 1 unsolved and brutal murder in 1998; and
- 2 WHEREAS, "Transgender Day of Remembrance" is now an annual
- 3 day of observance to honor the memory of all individuals whose
- 4 lives were lost in acts of anti-transgender violence and bring
- 5 attention to the continued violence endured by transgender
- 6 people; and
- 7 WHEREAS, In 2024, at least 27 transgender and gender-
- 8 expansive people have had their lives taken tragically through
- 9 violent means, with 63% killed with a gun; and
- 10 WHEREAS, As in previous years, many were Black and Latine
- 11 transgender women; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The designation of "Transgender Awareness Week" and
- 13 "Transgender Remembrance Day" in Pennsylvania raises much-needed
- 14 awareness of the violence and injustice that transgender people
- 15 continue to face each day and encourages us to mourn and honor
- 16 their lives by expressing love, support and respect for all
- 17 transgender people; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Senate and the General Assembly must act to
- 19 protect and preserve the lives of all transgender people by
- 20 prioritizing funding and legislation; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of November 13
- 22 through 19, 2024, as "Transgender Awareness Week" and November
- 23 20, 2024, as "Transgender Day of Remembrance" in Pennsylvania.
