A RESOLUTION

- Designating November 7, 2024, as "Victims of Communism Memorial Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The year 2024 marks 33 years since the fall of the
- 4 Soviet Union; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Based on the philosophy of Karl Marx, communism has
- 6 proven incompatible with the ideals of liberty, prosperity and
- 7 dignity of human life and has given rise to such infamous
- 8 totalitarian dictators as Joseph Stalin, Mao Zedong, Ho Chi
- 9 Minh, Pol Pot, Nicolae Ceauşescu, the Castro brothers and the
- 10 Kim dynasty; and
- 11 WHEREAS, One-fifth of the world's population still live under
- 12 communist tyranny in countries like China, Venezuela and Cuba
- 13 where atrocities like genocide, food shortages, forced labor and
- 14 internment occur; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Victims of Communism Museum opened on June 13,
- 16 2022, in Washington, DC, to educate visitors about the history
- 17 and horrors of communism; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Communist regimes worldwide have killed more than

- 1 100 million people and subjected countless others to the worst
- 2 and widest-spread human rights abuses known to history, with
- 3 victims representing many different ethnicities, creeds and
- 4 backgrounds; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Through false promises of equality and liberation,
- 6 communist regimes have, as a matter of government policy, robbed
- 7 residents of the rights of freedom of religion, freedom of
- 8 speech and freedom of association through coercion, brutality
- 9 and fear; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Many victims of communism were persecuted as
- 11 political prisoners for speaking out against these communist
- 12 regimes and others were killed in genocidal, state-sponsored
- 13 purges; and
- 14 WHEREAS, In addition to violating basic human rights,
- 15 communist regimes have suppressed freedom of conscience,
- 16 cultural life and self-determination movements in more than 40
- 17 nations; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Victims of Communism Memorial Foundation in
- 19 Washington, DC, a nonprofit organization authorized by a
- 20 unanimous act of the Congress of the United States, educates
- 21 people about the ideology, history and legacy of communism and
- 22 honors those who have suffered and died under communist regimes;
- 23 therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 designate November 7, 2024, as "Victims of Communism Memorial
- 26 Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Senate of the
- 28 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania transmit a copy of this resolution
- 29 to the Victims of Communism Memorial Foundation so that members
- 30 of the organization may be apprised of the Commonwealth's action

- 2 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Senate of the
- 3 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania post this designation on the
- 4 publicly accessible Internet website of the Senate.
