A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the ongoing military conflict in Ukraine and
2 strongly condemning the Russian actions that have taken place
3 during the past year.

4 WHEREAS, On February 24, 2022, the Russian Federation invaded
5 Ukraine in a major escalation of the Russo-Ukrainian War; and

6 WHEREAS, Russia's illegal invasion resulted in Europe's
7 largest refugee crisis since World War II; and

8 WHEREAS, Due to Russia's invasion, hundreds of thousands of
9 soldiers have been killed during the ensuing battles; and

10 WHEREAS, The ongoing conflict has resulted in as many as
11 30,000 civilian casualties; and

12 WHEREAS, The Federal Government has provided approximately
13 \$80 billion of financial aid to Ukraine, with the assistance
14 spread between humanitarian efforts as well as financial and
15 military assistance; and

16 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is home to the second highest
17 number of Ukrainian-Americans in the United States; and

18 WHEREAS, Immigrants from Ukraine have been instrumental in

1 the cultural, economic and religious growth of this Commonwealth
2 for the past century; and

3 WHEREAS, It is incumbent upon global leaders to continue the
4 economic sanctions that strain the Russian economy in an attempt
5 to bring this conflict to an end; therefore be it

6 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the ongoing military
7 conflict in Ukraine and strongly condemn the Russian actions
8 that have taken place during the past year; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the Senate encourage the international
10 community to place the needed pressure on Russia to stop the
11 illegal and inhumane invasion on the Ukrainian people.
