4 WHEREAS, Dallas Green had an illustrious 62-year career in  
5 various player and executive roles in Major League Baseball,  
6 spending 46 of those years with the Philadelphia Phillies; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Green passed away on March 22, 2017, at 82 years  
8 of age; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Green believed in teaching the fundamentals and  
10 maintaining the integrity of the game; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Green posted a record of 169 wins and 130 losses  
12 as the General Manager of the Phillies and led the team to the  
13 franchise's first World Series victory in 1980; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Green later managed the Chicago Cubs, New York  
15 Yankees and New York Mets and most recently served as a senior  
16 advisor to the last four Phillies general managers; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Green represented many things to many people,

1 among them a beloved family man, dedicated worker and avowed  
2 community steward who gave of his heart and time to enhance the  
3 quality of life of his family and his community; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Green's inspiring presence and genuine love for  
5 his family and friends will live long in the hearts and memories  
6 of the many individuals whose lives he touched; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Senate honor the life and mourn the loss  
8 of Dallas Green, whose life greatly benefited all those who
