A RESOLUTION

1 2	Recognizing the month of March 2023 as "National Social Work Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Individuals enter the social work profession due to
4	a strong desire to help empower individuals, families,
5	communities and our nation to overcome the issues that prevent
6	them from reaching their full potential; and
7	WHEREAS, Social workers have worked for more than a century
8	to improve the well-being and enhance the basic needs of all
9	people; and
10	WHEREAS, Social workers follow a code of ethics which calls
11	on them to fight social injustice and respect the dignity and
12	worth of all people; and
13	WHEREAS, Social workers positively touch the lives of
14	millions of Americans each day and in a variety of places,
15	including schools, hospitals, the military, child welfare
16	agencies, community centers and in Federal, State and local
17	government; and

1 WHEREAS, The theme for this year's "National Social Work 2 Month" is "Social Work Breaks Barriers," which embodies how 3 social workers help empower individuals, families, communities 4 and our society to overcome the hurdles that prevent them from 5 achieving better well-being; and

6 WHEREAS, Social workers are the largest group of mental 7 health care providers in the United States, working daily to 8 support thousands of Americans in overcoming mental illnesses, 9 including depression and anxiety; and

10 WHEREAS, Social workers are on the front lines of the 11 nation's opioid addiction crisis, assisting individuals in 12 receiving the treatment they need to prevail over substance use 13 disorders; and

14 WHEREAS, Social workers help individuals to cope with death 15 and grief and help individuals and communities recover from 16 natural disasters that are increasingly fueled by our warming climate, including hurricanes, drought and flooding; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Social workers help this nation live up to its values by advocating for equal rights for all, including people 19 20 of color, people who are Indigenous, people who are LGBTQIA2S+ or people who follow various faiths; and 21

WHEREAS, The social work profession is one of the fastest 22 23 growing careers in the United States, with approximately 708,000 24 social workers today and more than 60,000 more social workers 25 expected to enter the profession over the next decade; and 26 WHEREAS, Social workers continue to push for changes that make our society a better place to live, including a livable 27 28 wage, improved workplace safety and social safety net programs 29 that help ameliorate poverty, hunger and homelessness; and 30 WHEREAS, Social workers endeavor to work throughout our
