A RESOLUTION

- Designating March 11, 2023, as "Suddenly Sleepy Saturday for Narcolepsy Awareness" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Narcolepsy is a chronic neurological disorder caused
- 4 by the brain's inability to regulate sleep-wake cycles; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Narcolepsy affects an estimated 1 in every 2,000
- 6 Americans; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Narcolepsy is an underrecognized and underdiagnosed
- 8 condition; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The symptoms of narcolepsy, especially when
- 10 undiagnosed, can lead to accidents, injuries and problems with
- 11 learning and working; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Narcolepsy affects people neurologically, socially
- 13 and emotionally; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Narcolepsy affects people of all ages, with onset
- 15 typically occurring between 10 and 30 years of age; and
- 16 WHEREAS, On average, it takes a patient more than six years
- 17 to be diagnosed with narcolepsy after first experiencing
- 18 symptoms; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Research shows that narcolepsy patients have an
- 2 increased prevalence of high blood pressure, cardiovascular
- 3 disease and diabetes; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Narcolepsy patients need trained providers to
- 5 address their comorbidities and treat additional underlying
- 6 health concerns; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Narcolepsy Network is a national organization
- 8 created to promote awareness of the disease and support for
- 9 those who suffer from narcolepsy; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate March 11, 2023, as
- 11 "Suddenly Sleepy Saturday for Narcolepsy Awareness" in
- 12 Pennsylvania.
