A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the 80th anniversary of the National Federation of
2 Independent Business on May 20, 2023.

3 WHEREAS, The National Federation of Independent Business
4 (NFIB), the leading small business association in the United
5 States, is celebrating 80 years as the voice of small businesses
6 across the United States; and

7 WHEREAS, NFIB is the voice for 13,000 small businesses in
8 this Commonwealth and 300,000 small businesses across the United
9 States; and

10 WHEREAS, The vision of NFIB is to give small and independent
11 businesses a voice in governmental decision making through
12 policy advocacy; and

13 WHEREAS, The positions of NFIB originate from the democratic
14 polling of NFIB grassroots membership and reflect the actual
15 interests of small business owners; and

16 WHEREAS, As a result, the efforts of NFIB lead to the growth
17 of small businesses and job creation; and

1 WHEREAS, NFIB has been honored by United States presidents,
2 members of Congress, governors and other elected officials for
3 bringing an understanding of the critical issues facing small
4 business owners to policymakers; and

5 WHEREAS, NFIB offers dedicated advocacy in Congress and in
6 all 50 state capitols, represents small business interests in
7 the courts and produces vital economic data on small business
8 trends; and

9 WHEREAS, For 80 years, NFIB has relentlessly advanced its
10 mission to promote and protect the right of NFIB members to own,
11 operate and grow their businesses, and advocated that small
12 businesses are engines of job growth, the lifeblood of American
13 entrepreneurship and essential to the creation of a better
14 standard of living for all; therefore be it
