It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21-27-11.11 of the General Laws in Chapter 21-27 entitled

2 "Sanitation in Food Establishments" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>21-27-11.11. Administrative fines. --</u> The division, after due notice and after opportunity

for a hearing, shall have the right to levy administrative fines of up to five hundred dollars (\$500)

5 one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the first offense, up to two thousand five hundred dollars

6 (\$2,500) for the second offense, and up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for every offense

7 thereafter, against any manager certified in food safety or food establishment who violates the

8 provisions of the rules and regulations governing food establishments.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
