It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 40-21 of the General Laws entitled "Medical Assistance —

2 Prescription Drugs" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

40-21-4. Prohibition of prior authorization or step therapy protocol.

4 (a) The Rhode Island medical assistance program, as defined by this chapter, and any

5 contract between the Rhode Island medical assistance program, as defined under chapter 8 of title

6 40, and a managed care organization shall not require prior authorization or a step therapy protocol

- 7 for the prescription of a nonpreferred medication classified as an anticonvulsant or antipsychotic
- 8 <u>on their drug formulary.</u>
- 9 (b) If the secretary of health and human services determines that authorization from a
- 10 federal agency is necessary for the implementation of this section, the executive office of health
- 11 and human services is authorized to seek such state plan amendment and may delay implementing
- 12 the provisions until the authorization is granted.
- 13 (c) The Rhode Island medical assistance program, as defined under chapter 8 of title 40,
- 14 shall require, through amending current and future medical assistance managed care contracts, that
- 15 the managed care organizations meet the provisions of this section.
- 16 (d) The provisions of subsection (a) of this section do not affect clinical prior authorization
- 17 edits to prescriptions of medications classified as an anticonvulsant or antipsychotic.
- 18 (e) This section does not prevent the Rhode Island medical assistance program, as defined

- 1 <u>under chapter 8 of title 40, and any contract between the Rhode Island medical assistance program</u>
- 2 and a managed care organization from denying an exception for a medication that has been removed
- 3 from the market due to safety concerns from the federal Food and Drug Administration.
- 4 (f) For the purposes of this section, "step therapy protocol" means a protocol that
- 5 establishes a specific sequence in which prescription medications for a specified medical condition
- 6 are medically necessary for a particular enrollee and are covered under a pharmacy or medical
- 7 <u>benefit by a carrier, including self-administered and physician-administered drugs.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and applies to all healthcare policies,
- 9 contracts, plans, and certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in
- 10 this state on or after January 1, 2026.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES -- MEDICAL ASSISTANCE -- PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

1 This act would define step therapy protocol and prohibit the Rhode Island medical 2 assistance program, and any contract between the Rhode Island medical assistance program and a 3 managed care organization from requiring prior authorization or a step therapy protocol for the 4 prescription of a nonpreferred medication classified as an anticonvulsant or antipsychotic. 5 This act would take effect upon passage and would apply to all policies, contracts, and 6 plans executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this state on or after January 7 1, 2026.

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
