SECTION 1. Title 42 of the General Laws entitled "STATE AFFAIRS AND

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

2 GOVERNMENT" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter: 3 CHAPTER 46.1 AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDINGS 4 42-46.1-1. Recordings to be made. -- All public bodies within state government and all 5 state public and quasi-public boards, agencies and corporations shall make audio and video 6 7 recordings of all meetings of the body and shall transmit the recordings of all open meetings 8 within thirty-five (35) days of the meeting to the office of the secretary of state, who shall post 9 the same on its website and make them available to the public in such format or formats as are 10 commonly used for internet transmission; provided that this section shall not apply to public bodies whose responsibilities are solely advisory in nature. 11

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
