RELATING TO ELECTIONS - VOTING DISTRICTS AND ELECTIONS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 17-11-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-11 entitled "Voting

2 Districts and Officials" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>17-11-1. Division of towns and representative district into voting districts. --</u> The

local board of any city or town may, on or before the sixtieth (60th) day preceding any election,

divide or redivide the town, or any representative district in the city or town, into voting districts.

6 The local board of each city shall determine voting districts by geographical boundaries and by

no other means. No voting district shall at any time comprise parts of two (2) or more wards. It

8 shall be the duty of the board to divide the town, representative district, or ward, so that

substantially not more than nineteen hundred (1900) voters shall be served by the same polling

10 place; provided, that subject to the approval of the state board, a local board may provide for

11 serving more than nineteen hundred (1900) voters in the same polling place where the effect to

12 the contrary would be of creating a polling place serving less than one hundred fifty (150) voters.

13 A polling place may be located either within or without the voting district for which it is

established; provided, that a polling place may be located outside the district only upon

unanimous determination of the local board and subject to the approval of the state board that a

suitable place is not available within the voting district. In making the calculation required by this

section, voters whose names are on the inactive list of voters shall not be included.

SECTION 2. Section 17-18-11 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-18 entitled "Elective

Meetings" is hereby amended to read as follows:

1	17-18-11. Time of closing of polls Elective meetings in all cities and towns shall be
2	continuously kept open for voting until 9 8 p.m.; provided, that any qualified voter who is within
3	the building in which the elective meeting is being conducted and is waiting in line to vote at $\frac{9}{8}$
4	p.m. shall be entitled to cast his or her vote. When all persons entitled to vote have been afforded
5	a reasonable opportunity to do so, the polls shall be closed; provided, that the city council of the
6	city of Pawtucket shall have the authority, solely in local elections, to close the polls one hour
7	earlier than set forth in this section.
8	SECTION 3. Section 17-20-13 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-20 entitled "Mail
9	Ballots" is hereby amended to read as follows:
10	<u>17-20-13. Form of application</u> The application to be subscribed by the voters before
11	receiving a mail ballot shall, in addition to those directions that may be printed, stamped, or
12	written on it by authority of the secretary of state, be in substantially the following form:

8	() 4. I belong to a religion whose tenets forbid secular activity, including voting, on the
9	day of election. Ballot will be mailed to address in BOX A.
10	() 5. 2. I am confined in a hospital, convalescent home, nursing home, rest home, or
11	similar institution. Complete BOX B above.
12	() 6. I am detained while awaiting trial or imprisoned for a cause other than final
13	conviction of a felony. Complete BOX B above.
14	() 7. 3. I am employed or in service intimately connected with military operations or
15	because I am a spouse or dependent of such person. Complete BOX B above or the ballot will be
16	mailed to the local board of canvassers.
17	() 8. I am employed by the (a)() state board of elections, (b)() elections division of the
18	secretary of state, (c)() a member of the staff of a local canvassing authority, (d)() or a poll
19	worker assigned to work election day outside of their voting district.
20	() 4. I may not be able to vote at my polling place on the day of election during voting
21	<u>hours.</u>
22	I declare that all of the information I have provided on this form is true and correct to the
23	best of my knowledge. I further state that I am not a qualified voter of any other city or town or
24	state and have not claimed and do not intend to claim the right to vote in any other city or town o
25	state.
26	If unable to sign name because of physical incapacity or otherwise, applicant shall make
27	his or her mark "X".
