It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8-19-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 8-19 entitled "Language
2 Interpreters — Use of Language Interpreters in Legal Proceedings" is hereby amended to read as
3 follows:

4 **8-19-7. Confidential communications.**

5 No interpreter/~~transliterater~~ translator appointed pursuant to this chapter to interpret or
6 translate for limited-English-proficient persons in proceedings before the state courts in Rhode
7 Island shall be called upon to testify concerning any statement(s) and/or confidential
8 communications made to them in connection with ~~the interpreter's or transliterater's~~ any
9 interpretation or ~~transliteration~~ translation, properly entrusted to the translator in their professional
10 capacity, without the consent of the person making the statement or unless compelled by court
11 order.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
