1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6-48 of the General Laws entitled "Consumer Empowerment and

Identity Theft Prevention Act of 2006" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following

6-48-8.1. Personal information - prohibition.

5 No telecommunications or Internet service provider that has entered into a franchise

6 agreement, right-of-way agreement, or other contract with the state of Rhode Island or political

7 subdivision, instrumentality or quasi-public agency of the same, or that uses facilities that are

8 subject to such agreements, even if it is not a party to the agreement, may collect personal

information from a customer resulting from the customer's use of the telecommunications or

10 <u>Internet service provider without express written approval from the customer. No such</u>

11 <u>telecommunication or Internet service provider shall refuse to provide its services to a customer</u>

12 on the grounds that the customer has not approved collection of the customer's personal

13 <u>information</u>.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
