It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-59 of the General Laws entitled "Board of Governors for Higher
- 2 Education [See Title 16 Chapter 97 The Rhode Island Board of Education Act]" is hereby
- 3 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 4 <u>16-59-9.2. Military tuition waiver.</u>
- Notwithstanding any other provision of the general or public laws to the contrary, an
- 6 applicant who is a member of the armed forces or reserves of the United States and is currently
- 7 <u>stationed in Rhode Island, shall be exempt from paying nonresident tuition at Rhode Island public</u>
- 8 universities, colleges or community colleges. The council on postsecondary education shall
- 9 prescribe rules and regulations as may be necessary for the implementation of this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
