It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 45-2 of the General Laws entitled "General Powers" is hereby
2	amended by adding thereto the following section:
3	45-2-59. Town of North Smithfield Municipal court (a) The town council of the
4	town of North Smithfield may establish a municipal court and confer upon the court original
5	jurisdiction, notwithstanding any other provisions of the general laws, to hear and determine
6	causes involving the violations of the town of North Smithfield Charter, Code of Ordinances,
7	including minimum housing ordinances of the town and any violation of the provisions of chapter
8	24.3 of this title, entitled the "Rhode Island Housing Maintenance and Occupancy Code";
9	provided, however, that any defendant found guilty of any offense, excluding violation of the
10	minimum housing ordinances or chapter 24.3 of this title, may within seven (7) days of
11	conviction, file an appeal from the conviction to the superior court for Providence County and be
12	entitled in the latter court to a trial de novo; and provided further, however, that any defendant
13	found guilty of any violation of a minimum housing ordinance or of chapter 24.3 may, within
14	seven (7) days of the conviction, file an appeal from the conviction to the sixth division of the
15	district court and be entitled to a trial de novo in accordance with subsections 8-8-3(a_(4) and 8-
16	<u>8-3.2.</u>
17	(b) With respect to violations of either municipal ordinances dealing with minimum
18	housing or chapter 24.3, et seq. of this title dealing with housing maintenance and occupancy, the

19 town council may also confer upon the municipal court, in furtherance of the court's jurisdiction,

1 the power to proceed according to equity: 2 (1) To restrain, prevent, enjoin, abate or correct a violation; 3 (2) To order the repair, vacation or demolition of any dwelling existing in violation; 4 (3) To otherwise compel compliance with all of the provisions of the ordinances and 5 statutes. 6 (c) The municipal court shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the Rhode Island Traffic 7 Tribunal to hear and adjudicate those violations conferred upon the municipal court and enumerated in section 818-3. Adjudication of summons by the municipal court shall be in 8 9 conformance with section 8-18-4. The municipal court shall hear and decide traffic matters in a 10 manner consistent with the procedures of the traffic tribunal, and be subject to review by the chief 11 judge of the district court in accordance with section 8-18-11. Any person desiring to appeal an 12 adverse decision of the municipal court for violations enumerated in section 818-3, may seek 13 review thereof pursuant to the procedures set forth in section 31-41.1-8. 14 (d) The town council of the town of North Smithfield is authorized and empowered to 15 appoint a judge and clerk of the municipal court. The town council of the town of North 16 Smithfield is authorized and empowered to enact ordinances governing the personnel, operation 17 and procedure to be followed in the court and to establish a schedule of fees and costs, and to 18 otherwise provide for the operation and management of the court. The municipal court may 19 impose a sentence not to exceed thirty (30) days in jail and impose a fine not in excess of five 20 hundred dollars (\$500), or both. The court is empowered to administer oaths, compel the 21 attendance of witnesses and punish persons for contempt and to execute search warrants to the 22 extent the warrants could be executed by a judge of the district court. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 23
