It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 19-14.9-6 of the General Laws in Chapter 19-14.9 entitled "Rhode 2 Island Fair Debt Collection Practices Act" is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 19-14.9-6. Harassment or abuse. -- A debt collector may not engage in any conduct the natural consequence of which is to harass, oppress, or abuse any person in connection with the 4 5 collection of a debt. Such conduct shall include, but not be limited to: 6 (a) Using or threatening to use violence or other criminal means to harm the physical 7 person, reputation, or property of any person; 8 (b) Using obscene or profane language or language the natural consequence of which is 9 to abuse the hearer or reader;
- 10 (c) Advertising for sale of any debt to coerce payment of the debt;
- 11 (d) Causing a telephone to ring or engaging any person in telephone conversation 12 repeatedly or continuously with intent to annoy, abuse, or harass any person at the called number;
 - (e) Except as provided in section 19-14.9-4, placing telephone calls without meaningful disclosure of the caller's identity-; and
- 15 (f) Placing telephone calls to any person on a Sunday.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
