#### MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES - MISCELLANEOUS RULES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-22-23 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-22 entitled

"Miscellaneous Rules" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 31-22-23. Tow trucks - Identification required. -- (a) Every motor vehicle used for the

purpose of towing or assisting disabled motor vehicles shall display, in sharp color contrast to the

background, and be of such size, shape, and color as to be readily legible during daylight hours,

from a distance of fifty feet (50') while the vehicle is not in motion; the name, address, and

telephone number of the registered owner shall be displayed on both sides of the vehicle.

(b) Any person violating this section shall be fined as provided in section 31-41.1-4.

(c) Any vehicle, except those vehicles exempt from regulation pursuant to the provisions

of section 39-12-3, which are used for the purpose of towing or assisting disabled motor vehicles,

11 which does not have a towing certificate issued by the division of public utilities must have the

words "Limited Towing" lettered upon the hood or fenders of the vehicle. The letters must be

four inches (4") high in a color which contrasts with the vehicle color and must be on both sides

of the hood or both sides of the front fender.

15 (1) A "Limited Towing" vehicle or motor carrier must meet and satisfy the security

16 requirements of section 39-12-27 by furnishing the administrator with evidence of insured

financial responsibility with proof of the carrier's ability to meet any and all legally established

18 <u>claim or claims for damages by reason of personal injury to or the death of, any one person in an</u>

amount of at least two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), or by reason of personal

2 thousand dollars (\$500,000), (subject to a maximum of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars

3 (\$250,000) for bodily injuries to or the death of one person), and for damages to property

(excluding cargo) in the amount of at least twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). A filing fee of

ten dollars (\$10.00) must accompany each insurance filing. All revenues received under this

section shall be deposited as general revenues.

(2) In addition, each "Limited Towing" motor carrier shall file with the administrator a certificate on blanks furnished by the administrator and issued by the general treasurer that the motor carrier has filed with the general treasurer a bond in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), issued by a surety company authorized to transact business in Rhode Island and conditioned upon payment of any sum up to and including the maximum amounts required in this section in the satisfaction of any final judgment rendered as the result of any claim, or claims

13 for damages against the motor carrier.

(d) Any person who shall violate this provision shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100) upon conviction for a first offense, not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) upon conviction for a second offense, and for each subsequent conviction may be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500).

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
