It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. The title of Chapter 23-12.7 of the General Laws entitled "The Breast 1 2 Cancer Act" is hereby amended to read as follows: **CHAPTER 23-12.7** 3 4 **The Breast Cancer Act** 5 **CHAPTER 23-12.7** 6 THE SLATER ACT 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 23-12.7 of the General Laws entitled "The Breast Cancer Act" is 8 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 9 23-12.7-4. Declaration of purpose. – (a) For the fiscal year 2010, the department of 10 health men and women's cancer screening program shall be funded by the state in the amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), and increased annually to adequately match 11 12 federal funds to cover the cost of mammography's for men and women between the ages of forty 13 (40) and forty-nine (49) who are eligible to use the Rhode Island men and women's cancer 14 screening program. 15 (b) The funding for the men and women's cancer screening program shall be from the general fund and shall be in addition to the funding received from any benefactor pursuant to this 16 17 chapter.

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1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
