It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21-36-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 21-36 entitled "The Inter-
2 Agency Food & Nutrition Policy Advisory Council" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **21-36-3. Council composition.** -- There shall be an inter-agency food and nutrition
4 policy advisory council which shall consist of ~~three (3)~~ seven (7) members: the director of health
5 or his or her designee; the director of environmental management or his or her designee; ~~and~~ the
6 director of administration or his or her designee; the director of the department of human services
7 or his or her designee; the director of the division of elderly affairs or his or her designee; the
8 director of the department of corrections or his or her designee; and the commissioner of
9 elementary and secondary education or his or her designee. The members of the commission shall
10 elect a chairperson from among themselves.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

1 This act would increase the membership of the Inter-agency food and nutrition policy
2 advisory council from three (3) to seven (7) members, expanding the council to include the
3 director of the department of human services, the director of the division of elderly affairs, the
4 director of the department of corrections and the commissioner of elementary and secondary
5 education or their designees.

6 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
