It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28-14-2.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-14 entitled "Payment
- 2 of Wages" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 28-14-2.2. Frequency of payment. -- Except as provided in sections 28-14-4 and 28-14-
- 4 5, every employee other than employees of the state and its political subdivisions and of religious,
- 5 literary, or charitable corporations shall be paid weekly, bi-weekly, or semi-monthly all due
- wages from his or her employer, except those employees whose compensation is fixed at a 6
- 7 biweekly, semi-monthly, monthly, or yearly rate-, and except for employees covered under a
- 8 collective bargaining agreement establishing a different frequency for such payments.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS -- PAYMENT OF WAGES

This act would allow employers to pay their employees on a bi-weekly or semi-monthly
basis. This act would also provide that the frequency of payment of wages under a collective
bargaining agreement would not be subject to any law requiring employees to be paid weekly, biweekly or semi-monthly.

This act would take effect upon passage.
