It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 27-18 of the General Laws entitled "Accident and Sickness 1 2 Insurance Policies" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 27-18-71. Mandatory collection of copayments prohibited. – Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary, no accident or sickness insurance policy shall mandate that any health 4 5 care provider collect deductibles for services provided to a patient. 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 27-19 of the General Laws entitled "Nonprofit Hospital Service 7 Corporations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 8 27-19-62. Mandatory collection of copayments prohibited. – Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary, no individual or group hospital or medical services contract plan or 9 policy shall mandate that any health care provider collect deductibles for services provided to a 10 11 patient. 12 SECTION 3. Chapter 27-20 of the General Laws entitled "Nonprofit Medical Service 13 Corporations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 14 27-20-57. Mandatory collection of copayments prohibited. -- Notwithstanding any 15 provisions to the contrary, no individual or group health insurance contract plan or policy shall mandate that any health care provider collect deductibles for services provided to a patient. 16

SECTION 4. Chapter 27-20.9 of the General Laws entitled "Contract With Health Care

Providers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

1	27-20.9-4. Mandatory collection of copayments prohibited Notwithstanding any

3	that any health care provider collect deductibles for services provided to a patient.
4	SECTION 5. Chapter 27-41 of the General Laws entitled "Health Maintenance
5	Organizations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
6	27-41-75. Mandatory collection of copayments prohibited Notwithstanding any
7	provisions to the contrary, no health maintenance organization contract plan or policy shall
8	mandate that any health care provider collect deductibles for services provided to a patient.
9	SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon passage.
