It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-75 of the General Laws entitled "Children's Product Safety Act"
- 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 23-75-6.1. Unsafe children's products children's jewelry. (a) As used in this
- 4 section, the following words shall have the following meanings:
- 5 (1) "Cadmium" means elemental cadmium and any compounds or alloys which contain
- 6 <u>cadmium; and</u>
- 7 (2) "Children's jewelry" means any jewelry, including charms, bracelets, pendants,
- 8 necklaces, earrings or rings, and any component thereof that is designed or intended to be worn or
- 9 used by children thirteen (13) years of age or younger.
- 10 (b) On and after July 1, 2014, no person shall manufacture, sell, offer for sale or
- 11 distribute in this state any children's jewelry that contains cadmium at more than seventy-five
- 12 thousandths percent (.0075%) by weight.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
