It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36-8-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 36-8 entitled "Retirement
2 System - Administration" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **36-8-10. Accounts and statistical records -- Clerical and professional assistance --**
4 **Disbursements.** -- The general treasurer, under the direction and supervision of the retirement
5 board, shall be charged with the establishment and maintenance of such accounts and statistical
6 records as the retirement board may require and he or she shall employ such clerical assistance as
7 shall be necessary to carry out properly the provisions of chapters 8 -- 10 of this title. The
8 retirement board shall secure the services of an actuary who shall be the actuarial advisor of the
9 board and who shall make the actuarial computations and valuations required by chapters 8 -- 10.
10 The retirement board shall secure the services of such physicians as shall be necessary to make
11 the medical examinations required by those chapters. The state controller is hereby authorized
12 and directed to draw his or her orders upon the general treasurer for the payment of such sum or
13 sums as may from time to time be necessary, upon receipt by him or her of vouchers prepared and
14 duly authenticated by the chief of the retirement system; provided, that no funds of the retirement
15 system shall be utilized to pay any salaries or benefits of employees of the state of Rhode Island
16 assigned or hired to perform normal daily duties within the general treasurer's office.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would require the general treasurer with the establishment and maintenance of
2 such accounts and statistical records required by the retirement board, and would allow he or she
3 to comply such clerical assistance to comply with the duties of the retirement board; provided,
4 that no funds of the retirement system would be utilized to pay any salaries or benefits of
5 employees of the state of Rhode Island assigned or hired to perform daily duties within the
6 general treasurer's office.

7 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
