It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13-8-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 13-8 entitled "Parole" is 2 hereby amended to read as follows: 13-8-2. Qualifications of board members. 3 The seven (7) electors to be named by the governor shall have the following qualifications: 4 5 (1)(i) One of the qualified electors shall be a psychologist or a physician who is professionally qualified in the field of psychiatry or neurology; 6 7 (ii) One shall be a member in good standing of the Rhode Island bar; 8 (iii) One shall be a person who is professionally trained in correctional work or in some 9 closely related general field as a social work; and 10 (iv) One shall be a law enforcement officer; and 11 (v) One shall be a person formerly incarcerated or directly impacted by the criminal legal 12 system who has completed the probation and parole process three (3) or more years prior with a 13 background in one of the following areas: psychology, mental health and/or substance use, transitional housing, re-entry after incarceration, education or law. 14 15 (2) All of the qualified electors shall be individuals who shall also have shown an interest in social welfare problems. 16
