8 Verdean Progressive Center, and served as Chairman of the Board of Governors; and

9 WHEREAS, In her free time, Mrs. Delgado was a passionate sports enthusiast. She was a
10 longtime member of the East Providence Volleyball League, a tenacious softball player and a
11 popular Little League coach. In her younger days, she had dreams of being a Roller Derby
12 competitor; and

13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Delgado loved music and was always one of the first people on the
14 dance floor. She was a revered story teller and was appreciated for her great sense of humor and
15 ability to fill a room of people with laughter; and

16 WHEREAS, In addition to her husband, Adrian, Mrs. Delgado leaves behind her
17 children, Adrian Delgado, Robert Delgado, and Sherita Delgado, her grandson Kyle Delgado and
18 great-grandson Harlem Delgado. She is also survived by her siblings, Mark Varela, Gary Varela,
19 Maryann Fonseca, Bernadette Varela, her uncle, Avelino Rose, and many in-laws, nephews,
20 cousins, and numerous friends, and was the sister of the late Steven Varela; now, therefore be it
