#### CONGRATULATING DENNIS AND SUSAN MCCOY ON BEING SELECTED AS 2011 NEWPORT DAILY NEWS COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD WINNERS

WHEREAS, The Newport Daily News established a "Community Service Award" in
1996 on the paper's 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration in order to recognize and encourage
volunteerism within the community; and
WHEREAS, Chosen from a field of more than a dozen nominations, Dennis McCoy, a
retired Navy Rear Admiral and former member of the Newport City Council, and his lovely wife,
Susan, a real estate agent, were selected as two of the 2011 recipients of this prestigious award for

the "variety of organizations" and "the lasting impact" of their volunteer efforts. They are only
the second couple to have ever received this honor; and

9 WHEREAS, Longtime residents of the City by the Sea, the McCoy's have consistently 10 and selflessly given their time, talent, and energy to a myriad of clubs and organizations 11 benefitting the citizenry of the City of Newport. They have been very active with the Newport 12 Public Education Foundation and St. Paul's United Methodist Church, where they oversee the 13 church's soup kitchen, as well as numerous other responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, Dennis is a trustee at St. Paul's United Methodist Church, and had served on
the Newport City Council for a number of years. He has also been active for many years with the
Newport Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, Susan began volunteering at hospitals as a young girl, and later with the
scouts. She has served as Treasurer for the church's soup kitchen, spent five years as chair of the
Newport Public Education Foundation, an organization that raises extra funding for programs and

projects that aren't covered in the city's strapped school budget, and she helps out with the
 "Newport to a Tea" fundraiser. She has also been involved with the Newport Music Festival and
 started the volunteer program, Rebuilding Together, that rehabilitates local homes; and

WHEREAS, Dennis and Susan are always happy to lend a hand. As a couple or sometimes on separate crusades, they not only support each other, but also, a panoply of altruistic endeavors and organizations; and

WHEREAS, The McCoy's devotion and commitment to the community is well known,
and their generosity of spirit is inspiring. They have earned the unqualified admiration and
respect of so many people in the community and they are truly role models for us all; now,
therefore be it
