CONGRATULATING FLORENCE ARCHAMBAULT ON BEING SELECTED AS ONE OF THE 2011 NEWPORT DAILY NEWS COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD WINNERS

Her parents 9 also instilled in her their deep commitment to community service. Through the years, Florence's 10 passion for writing and literature not only determined the career she would eventually choose, but 11 also developed into a skill and knowledge she could utilize to help others; and 12 WHEREAS, Florence is a longtime freelance writer. She has published histories of 13 Mumford Manor, a biography of Maude Howe Elliott, and magazine stories on collecting antiques, and has written press releases for local groups. In addition, she taught in the Circle of 14 15 Scholars program at Salve Regina University and teaches a free course on writing family histories 16 at the Edward King House Senior Center; and 17 WHEREAS, Beginning in the 1970s, Florence's community involvement has included

membership in myriad organizations, including the Daughters of the American Revolution, the

Church Community Housing Corporation, the Mumford Manor Housing Corporation, the

1	Newport Public Library bookstore, and the United Congregational Church, where she runs a flea
2	market, a prayer group, and a knitting group. She is quite well known for her lovely "prayer
3	shawls"; and
4	WHEREAS, Florence also contributes her time and talents with the Boys & Girls Clubs,
5	and is a member and the program chair for the local chapter of the AARP; and
6	WHEREAS, Never one to remain idle and showing no signs of slowing down in the
7	foreseeable future, Florence Archambault is a whirlwind of energy and kindness. In between
8	volunteering countless hours and spending time with her beloved children and grandchildren, she
9	still finds time to read eight or nine books a week; now, therefore be it

11	hereby congratulates and honors Florence Archambault on being selected as one of the 2011
12	Newport Daily News Community Service Award winners. Her years of devoted service to the
