It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-32-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-32 entitled "Obstructing
- 2 Justice" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>11-32-1. Obstructing officer in execution of duty. --</u> Every person who shall obstruct
- 4 any officer, civil, military, or otherwise, including any state, city, or town police, sheriff, or fire
- 5 fighter, or state constable, while in the execution of his or her office or duty, shall be imprisoned
- 6 not exceeding one year or be fined not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500).
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
