It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 20-14 of the General Laws entitled "Birds" is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto the following section:

3 **20-14-8.2. West shore of the Providence River.** – No person shall take, kill, destroy, or
4 pursue or in any manner molest any wild bird in that part of the cities of Warwick and Cranston
5 on the west shore of that portion of upper Narragansett Bay, which is also known as the
6 Providence River, from Gaspee Point to Fields Point or within one thousand feet (1,000') of the
7 west shore or banks of the Providence River from Gaspee Point to Fields Point.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

- 1 This act would prohibit the taking, killing, destroying, pursuing or molesting of any wild
- 2 bird along the west shore of the Providence River from Gaspee Point to Fields Point.
