It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 9-5-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 9-5 entitled "Writs, Summons
 and Process" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 9-5-7. Direction of writs for arrest or execution against the body. -- All writs
 whatsoever, commanding the arrest of a defendant, or executions running against the body of a
 defendant, shall be directed for service only to the division of sheriffs, or state licensed constables
 with full power, or if the writ is to be served in the town of New Shoreham, it may be directed to
 the town sergeant of the town, subject to the provisions of section 9-5-8, and no writ of arrest
 shall be served by any other officer.
 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
