It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 5-19.1 of the General Laws entitled "Pharmacies" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 5-19.1-36. Prescription drug price savings. 4 (a) Pharmacists when dispensing a prescription shall advise the individual presenting the 5 prescription of every substitute drug containing all the same active chemical ingredients of the same strength, quantity and dosage available at a lesser cost, unless ordered by the prescribing 6 7 physician to dispense as brand name necessary on the prescription form. 8 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply if the pharmacist is automatically 9 charging the individual presenting the prescription with the lowest price active chemical 10 ingredients of the same strength, quantity and dosage.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
