RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- SEXUAL ASSAULT – SHERRY’S LAW

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-37-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-37 entitled "Sexual
2 Assault" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **11-37-3. Penalty for first degree sexual assault.**

4 Every person who shall commit sexual assault in the first degree shall be imprisoned for a
5 period not less than ~~ten (10)~~ fifteen (15) years; provided that, the first ten (10) years shall be served
6 and the person shall not be afforded the benefits of deferment or suspension of sentence and may
7 be imprisoned for life.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall be applicable to all those
9 offenses committed after the effective date of this section.

EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
OF

RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- SEXUAL ASSAULT – SHERRY’S LAW

1 This act would increase the minimum sentence for first degree sexual assault and provide
2 that the first ten (10) years of a sentence for first degree sexual assault not be subject to a suspension
3 or deferment of sentence.

4 This act would take effect upon passage and shall be applicable to all those offenses
5 committed after the effective date of this section.
