It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Title 6 of the General Laws entitled "COMMERCIAL LAW — GENERAL
2	REGULATORY PROVISIONS" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter:
3	<u>CHAPTER 40.1</u>
4	SENIOR SAVINGS PROTECTION ACT
5	<u>6-40.1-1. Short title.</u>
6	This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Senior Savings Protection Act".
7	6-40.1-2. No fees to senior citizens for provision of paper documents.
8	It is unlawful for any person engaged in the sale of goods or services to charge any fee to
9	any person who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older, for a hard-copy paper bill, statement or
10	invoice.
11	<u>6-40.1-3. Penalty.</u>
12	Any person who violates the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed to have committed
13	a deceptive trade practice and is subject to the penalty set forth in § 6-13.1-14.
14	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2025.
