RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES -- GENERAL PROVISIONS

Introduced By: Senators Ruggerio, McBurney, Felag, Picard, and Goodwin

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3-1-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 3-1 entitled "General
2 Provisions" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **3-1-5. Liberal construction of title.** -- This title shall be construed liberally in aid of its
4 declared purpose which declared purpose is the promotion of temperance and for the reasonable
5 control of the traffic in alcoholic beverages; provided, however, that the promotion of incentive
6 programs or discounts for any person sixty-five (65) years of age or older, active duty members
7 of the armed forces of the United States, and members of the National Guard or Reserves shall be
8 allowed.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
