It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. The title of Chapter 39-1.1 of the General Laws entitled "Termination of
2	Service to Persons Who Are Disabled and Seriously Ill" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	CHAPTER 39-1.1
4	Termination of Service to Persons Who Are Disabled and Seriously III
5	<u>CHAPTER 39-1.1</u>
6	TERMINATION OF SERVICE TO PERSONS WHO ARE DISABLED, SERIOUSLY ILL OR
7	ARE IN ARREARS OF PAYMENT
8	SECTION 2. Section 39-1.1-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 39-1.1 entitled
9	"Termination of Service to Persons Who Are Disabled and Seriously III" is hereby amended to
10	read as follows:
11	<u>39-1.1-1.</u> Compliance with rules prior to termination. – (a) No public utility which
12	distributes electricity or supplies natural or manufactured gas, electric, or water service shall
13	terminate service to any household in which all adult residents are sixty-five (65) years of age or
14	older, or where any resident is disabled or seriously ill, for failure to pay an outstanding
15	indebtedness for service, without first complying with all rules and regulations for such
16	terminations issued by the commission.
17	(b) A utility shall not shut off service to a household if the person's bill is three hundred
18	dollars (\$300) or less and not more than three (3) months in arrears.
19	(c) Service may not be terminated unless two (2) notices of termination have been sent.

SECTION 3. Section 39-1.1-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 39-1.1 entitled
 "Termination of Service to Persons Who Are Disabled and Seriously III" is hereby amended to
 read as follows:
 <u>39-1.1-2. Determination of persons subject to nontermination. – (a)</u> The commission

- shall promulgate appropriate rules and regulations to determine which persons who are elderly,
 disabled, or seriously ill are subject to the nontermination provisions of section 39-1.1-1, and in
 what manner relief will be made available to the subject persons.
- 8 (b) The rules and regulations to determine which persons who are elderly, disabled,
- 9 seriously ill, or who have young children in the residence shall be through a short simplified
- 10 <u>declaration</u>.
- 11 (c) In the case of the elderly a declaration of age stating the occupant's name, date of
- 12 <u>birth and the name of the person billed will be sufficient.</u>
- 13 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
