It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 23-19 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Resource
2	Recovery Corporation" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3	23-19-10.4. Used medication. – (a) The resource recovery corporation shall develop a
4	statewide used medication collection program. The purposes of this program are to protect the
5	public from the health hazards of flushing or disposing of used medications in household trash,
6	protect the public drinking water supply and aquatic ecosystems from the harmful chemicals in
7	used medications, and limit drug related crimes and opportunities for drug abuse.
8	(b) The corporation shall develop the collection program in partnership with the
9	department of health, department of environmental management and the state police. The
10	collection program shall include, but not be limited to, the following provisions:
11	(1) Collection opportunities for both nonregulated materials and controlled substances;
12	(2) Safe disposal locations and/or return-by-mail programs for proper disposal of used
13	medications;
14	(3) Requirements for the destruction of the used medications;
15	(4) Defined responsibilities for each cooperating agency;
16	(5) Penalties for violating any section of the program; and
17	(6) Public education and information on the proper disposal of used medications.
18	(c) The used medication collection program shall be implemented no later than January 1,
19	<u>2011.</u>

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
