It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 37 of the General Laws entitled "Retail Licenses" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 3-7-16.8. Class TO license. – (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of the general or 4 public laws to the contrary, the Providence licensing board is hereby authorized to issue a class 5 TO license to any take-out restaurant whose premises are located in Plat Book 68, Lot 732 and within two hundred feet (200') of a place of public worship. The class TO license grants to 6 7 following privileges: 8 (1) The right to keep for sale and to sell beverages at retail at the place described in the 9 license and to deliver those beverages for consumption on the premises. 10 (2) The annual fee for the license shall be the same as a class B license in the city of 11 Providence and is payable to the city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
