It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-5-8.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-5 entitled "Assaults" is

2 hereby amended to read as follows:

11-5-8.1. Assault with bodily fluid. -- Any person incarcerated or in custody at a state

correctional facility including the juvenile training school who shall knowingly and willfully

5 commit an assault upon a correctional officer or any other employee of the department of

6 corrections with any bodily fluid, while the employee is engaged in the performance of his or her

7 duty, shall be imprisoned not exceeding five (5) years, or fined not less than five hundred dollars

8 (\$500) nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both. Any sentence imposed pursuant to

this section shall be imposed consecutively to, and not concurrently with, any sentence previously

10 imposed.
