It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 34-4 of the General Laws entitled "Estates in Real Property" is

hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

34-4-2.1. Reservation of life estate with enhanced powers. – A grantor may convey

title to real estate and reserve a life estate therein coupled with the reserved power and authority,

5 <u>during his or her lifetime, to sell, convey, mortgage or otherwise dispose of the real estate without</u>

6 the consent or joinder of the holders of the remainder interest. A duly-executed conveyance by

7 the life tenant exercising such reserved powers shall, upon recording, vest good title to the

8 interest conveyed in the grantee thereof, free and clear of any right, title and interest of the

holders of the remainder interest and without the necessity of any additional conveyance by any

10 <u>such remainderman.</u>

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SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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This act would in real estate recognize an enhanced life estate which empowers the
grantor who reserved a life estate to sell, convey, mortgage or dispose of real estate without the
consent of the holder of the remainder interest.

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
