It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-41-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-41 entitled "Theft,
- 2 Embezzlement, False Pretenses, and Misappropriation" is hereby repealed.
- 3 <u>11-41-10. Robbing of fish nets and weirs.</u>
- 4 Every person who shall rob or draw any fishpot, weir, or net belonging to any other
- 5 person shall be fined not exceeding twenty dollars (\$20.00).
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
