SECTION 1. Section 5-22-12 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-22 entitled "Shows and

2 Exhibitions" is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-22-12. License fees -- Revocation of license.

4 Town or city councils, bureaus of licenses, or boards of police commissioners shall

demand and receive of every person to whom a license is granted under this chapter a sum not

exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100) for any single performance, show, exhibition, concert,

7 entertainment, moving picture exhibition, dance or ball, that they deem proper; provided, that

performances and entertainments given by religious and charitable societies and volunteer fire-8

fighting companies duly organized and incorporated for the purpose of furthering their religious,

benevolent, or fire-fighting work are excepted from the provisions of this chapter as to fees. Any

license granted under the authority of §§ 5 22 5 - 5 22 12 may be revoked at the pleasure of that

city or town council, bureau of licenses or board of police commissioners.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 13
