SECTION 1. Chapter 4-19 of the General Laws entitled "Animal Care" is hereby

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 <u>4-19-22. Disposition conditions.</u> – <u>In addition to any other applicable law regarding the</u> 4 disposition of animals, animal shelters shall meet the following conditions before euthanizing an 5 animal pursuant to this chapter: (1) The holding period for the animal has expired; and 6 7 (2) There are no empty cages, kennels or other living environments in the shelter suitable 8 for the animal; and 9 (3) A foster home is not available through another municipal or private animal shelter or 10 Rhode Island incorporated animal organization; and (4) Another municipal or private animal shelter or Rhode Island incorporated animal 11 12 organization is unwilling to accept the animal; and 13 (5) The animal care or control manager of the animal shelter has certified that the above 14 conditions have been met and that he/she has no other reasonable alternative. 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
