It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 45-2 of the General Laws entitled "General Powers" is hereby amended by adding the following section:

45-2-5.2. Consolidation of municipal departments. – (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the general or public laws to the contrary, each town and city school district shall have only one municipal department performing human resources/personnel information technology, purchasing and maintenance functions. Accordingly they should consolidate these

7 operations by July 1, 2012. The human resources and personnel functions shall be exempt from

8 this requirement if their consolidation would compromise confidentiality mandates.

(b) In the event that these functions are not consolidated by October 1, 2012, then in such event, the auditor general shall have the power to effectuate the consolidation of the aforementioned functions. This section shall not be applied so as to interfere with existing labor contracts in effect on the date of enactment.

(c) To the extent that a consolidation contemplated by this section results in a reduction
 of an annual appropriation for the use of the schools, then such reduction shall not be deemed a

violation of section 16-7-24.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
